

Goose Creek Trailhead off of Trail Creek

Trailhead Name: Goose Creek	Circle one <u>Beginner</u> Intermediate Advanced
General Location: 12 miles east of Bozeman off of Trail Creek Rd	
Usage: Multi-use with hikers, bikers, and ATVs	
Directions From Bozeman: Get on I-90 towards Livingston and go 7 miles to Trail Creek Rd (exit 316). Go right and head 3 miles on Trail Creek to Goose Creek. Turn right on gravel road with Forest Service sign. About .5 miles up Goose Creek the trail forks to the right. Stay right and head up to the trailhead which has ample parking for trailers.	
Parking: 4-5 trailers, easy turn a round lightly used trailhead	
Highlights: Logging roads with great footing and views. Lots of moose, bear, and elk sightings. There are cattle leases on this trail so close all the gates that are opened. Trail Creek cabin is on the logging road and has a nice corral for horses. Contact USFS to rent. Past the cabin are single tracks with steep downhills, downed trees, and muddy conditions	
Be Aware: Shared use trail with bikers,ATVers, sometimes motorcycles. There are cattle leases on this trail so close all the gates that are opened.	
Land Status: Forest Service roads
